

Welcome to the Upper Level of the Dunn Community Center!

This is a community facility, and its success relies on renters like yourself to make sure it's kept in the best shape possible!

- **Keep it clean;** you are responsible for cleaning the facility at the conclusion of your rental. Cleaning supplies are located in the kitchen.



- **Take out the trash and recycling;** trash and recycling dumpsters are located in the lower parking lot. Please replace bags in all trash cans.



- **Don't blow a fuse!** As you can see, you are in a rehabbed original dairy barn. The electric is good, but can be overloaded. You may use appliances with heating elements (i.e. crockpot, etc.), but **ONLY plug in to an outlet with a RED cover.**
- **NO OPEN FLAMES.** Yes, this includes sterno.
- Decorations are permitted (by all means, make the space pretty!), with the following restrictions:
 - ⇒ **NO confetti or glitter;**
 - ⇒ **NO scotch/masking/duct tape on the walls, ceiling or barn beams;**
 - ⇒ **NO nails, tacks, staples, etc. on the walls, ceiling, or barn beams;**
 - ⇒ **NO command strips or hooks on the walls, ceiling or barn beams;**
 - ⇒ **NO helium balloons. Any air-filled balloons must be removed from the facility at the end of your party.** Please don't leave them inflated in the trash cans or dumpster.

- **NO ALCOHOL.**

- **NO SMOKING.** Smoking is prohibited on the property, this includes the parking lot.



- **Smile for the cameras.** This facility is under 24/7 surveillance.
- **Be sure to turn off all lights and exit the facility by the end of your rental period.** Doors will lock automatically.
- **WiFi Network:** The Dunn Center Guest Password is **Guest4565** **Note: speed cannot be guaranteed. Emergency maintenance cannot repair the WiFi.*
